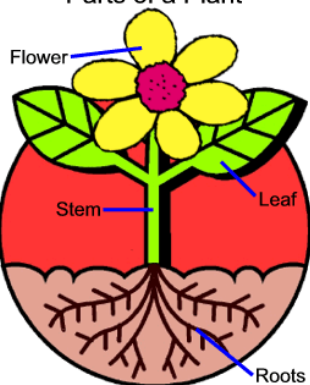
LITERACY

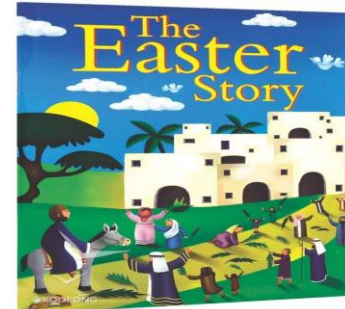

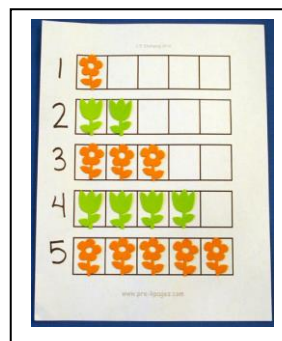


Numeracy Number

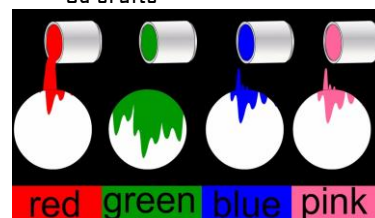
Shapes, space and measures
